



ANDROID USER GUIDE

SEVEN EYE The Seven Eye app for Android is intuitive to use and needs little further explanation, however some useful hints and tips are provided below.

LOGIN

To login to the app,
use the same user name(s)
and password(s) that you
use for the Seven Eye
tracking website:

Username

Password

→ Login

Select “**Remember Username**”
for the Username to be
remembered between logins.

Select “**Auto Login**” for the
Username and Password
to be remembered
between logins.

LOCATION MAP AND SNAIL TRAIL MAP

Touch on a map
location marker to see
location data and
(where applicable)

Maps can be zoomed by tapping the screen “+” and “-” buttons or by using pinch-to-zoom, and the map view can be changed between Standard and Hybrid modes via the Android context menu button.

JOURNEYS AND SENSORS SCREENS

Use the Previous Day, Calendar and Next Day buttons to view historical GPS data, Transcan data and CANbus data.

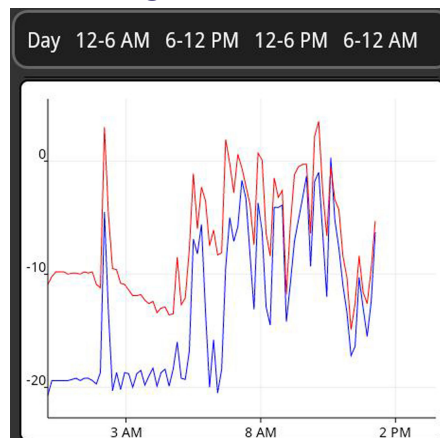

DATA IN THE SENSORS SCREEN

Touch on a time range in the chart toolbar to zoom into the chart for that time range:



Press any of the sensor buttons underneath the chart to see temperature probe and switch data in table format:
